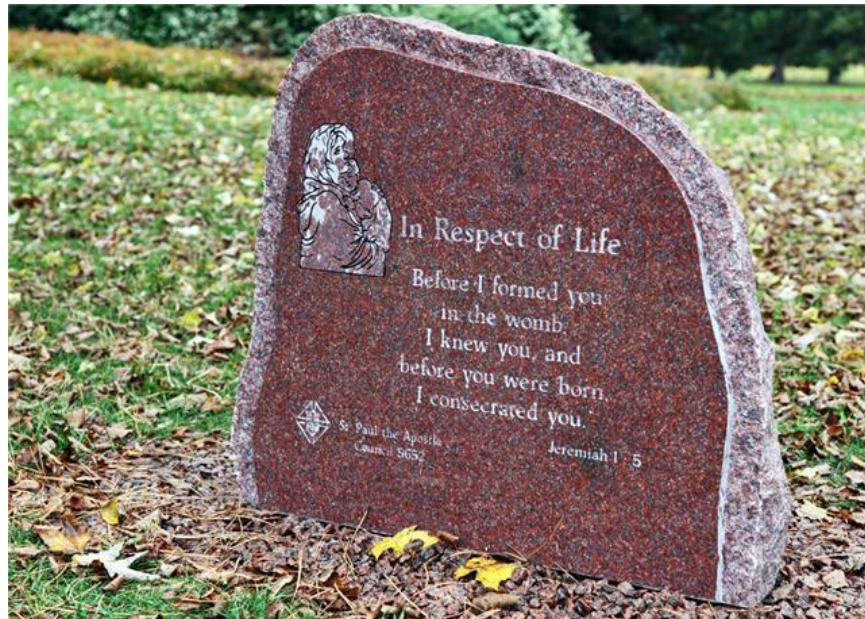


## Council 9652 Newsletter – Late News (Nov-Dec)
